All domestic wood species used for making these bobbins is sourced from wood grown in Ontario, Canada. Sources include sustainably managed forests, trees downed in storms, invasive species removals, farm woodlot harvesting and city tree pruning.

Tropical wood species are sourced only from FSC certified suppliers.

NOTE: Some tropical species are now listed as endangered. Any such species will not be available. Species include; most Rosewoods, Pink Ivory, African Blackwood, Ebony, Verawood, Bocote.

End of bobbin is signed with my logo, and wood species code.

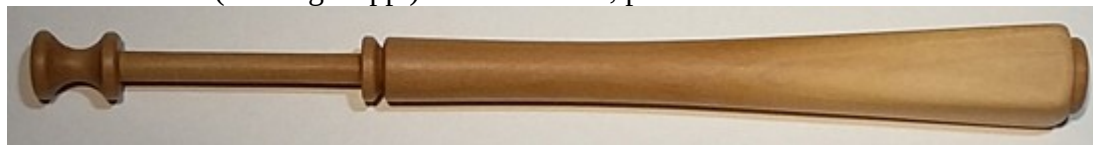
